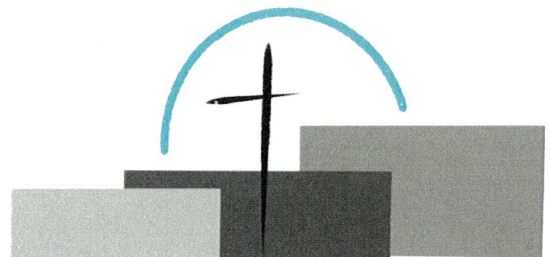
Let me know if you have any questions. Through you, the mission and ministries of our congregation are made real as we build on the faith here. Thank you!
